## THE HOLIDAYS ARE COMING . . .

## . . . AND SO IS WINTER!

Two different companies will be used to plow the snow and salt the lot again in 2012-2013 at Columbus Square, improving the snow removal process. The center was divided into two parcels and each company will do one of the parcels (half the center). The on-site maintenance men will fill in where needed as always. We believe this change will allow for the snow and ice to get plowed and salted faster, as more snow plows will be on site sooner after each snowfall.

ALL snow removal contractors for Hadler Real Estate Management locations are to adhere to the following directions: **The contractor must always be vigilant and listen to various local weather forecasts and be prepared to mobilize to get the work done.**

### If it snows between midnight and 5 AM:

- 1" or more - The drive lanes and entrances are all plowed and salted before the stores open.

- Special attention is to be given to the parking field in front of:
- Stores that open very early;
- Other stores with shopping carts;
- Handicap parking spaces;
- Delivery areas at the rear of Center should also be plowed and salted, but last.



### If it snows during the daytime hours:

- The contractor plows the drive lanes and entrances, then salts. This may be the best that can be done during the day.
- The contractor returns at night to plow and salt the entire center.

### During daytime icy conditions:

- The contractor salts the drive lanes and entrances.

### Reminder

All snow or ice removal on the sidewalks in front of your store is always your responsibility.

# Tenant Store Alterations

Many tenants call the Leasing Department in reference to making alterations within their given storeroom. We, as landlords, will almost always approve these alterations, especially since hopefully they will add to the tenant's success.

There are a few guidelines that need to be followed for alterations to your store, so it is absolutely necessary that we be alerted before the tenant proceeds to make any changes for the following reasons:

- They must be completed according to the local municipalities' building codes;
- Permits are usually required, and are the responsibility of the tenant;
- They must be non-structural in nature;
- They must be completed by a licensed contractor;
- Any roof penetration ALWAYS requires our approval because one small penetration could void a long-term roof warranty, and require that the roof warrantor's contractor perform the work;
- Any dumpsters, contractor parking, etc., must be coordinated with our property management department;
- Plans must be provided to us so that we have a clear understanding of what has been done in case a tenant vacates the premises.
